Beyond 30 days the cost of the required WU Study Abroad Insurance Plan is \$1.00 a day. If the student is participating on a program which includes Emergency Medical Evacuation and Repatriation and Health Insurance coverage that is equal to the WU Study Abroad Insurance Plan the fee may be waived. The student will need to submit a copy of the provider's insurance policy for the waiver to be approved.
